## Knitting Needle Size: 8 or 5 mm

Yarn Weight: (4) Medium Weight/Worsted Weight and Aran (16-20 stitches to 4 inches)

#### Materials:

- Bernat® Mosaic<sup>™</sup> (100 g/3.5 oz; 191 m/209 yds); Into the Woods (44012) 2 balls
- Size 5 mm (U.S.8) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

#### GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

#### ABBREVIATIONS

cr2B = Knit into back of 2nd stitch on needle, then knit first stitch, slipping both stitches off needle at same time.

cr2P = Purl into front of 2nd stitch on needle then purl first stitch, slipping both stitches off needle at same time.

### INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 34 sts. 1st to 4th rows: Knit. 5th row: (RS). K4. \*Cr2B. K2. Rep from \* to last 6 sts. Cr2B. K4. 6th row: K4. \*yf. Cr2P. yb. K2. Rep from \* to last 6 sts. yf. Cr2P. yb. K4. Rep 5th and 6th rows until work rows beg measures 59½" [151 cm]. Knit 4 rows. Cast off.

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
