Using beautiful yarn that changes the color for you, you can have this soft and cabled scarf finished to wear on the next wonder-fall day in no time!

Skill Level: Intermediate

Size: 8" wide x 60" long

Gauge: 16 sts and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stitch pattern

MATERIALS

Yarn:

Red Heart Boutique Unforgettable (100% Acrylic; 280 yards [256 meters]/100 grams): 3977 Sunrise, 2 balls.

Hook: US size J/10 (6.0 mm)

Notions: Tapestry needle

PATTERN NOTES

Scarf is worked back and forth in row

PATTERN

Ch 34.

Row 1: Dc in 4 ch from hook and in each ch across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, *sk next 2 sts, tr in each of next 2 sts, working in front of tr sts just made, tr in each skipped sts; rep from * across row, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, BPdc in next st and in each st across, turn.

Repeat Rows 2-3 until piece measures 60" or desired length
Fasten off.
